## Site Landfill Conditions of Use Agreement Form



The Roy Hill Mine Landfill Facility is available for use by Contractors. The landfill is licensed by the Department of Environment Regulation and are governed by the following legal requirements:

- *Environmental Protection Act 1986*
- *Environmental Protection (Controlled Waste) Regulations 2004*
- Department of Environment Regulation Operating Licence (L8621/2011/1)

### Permitted Wastes

The following wastes are permitted to be placed in the site landfills:

- Dry, inert construction waste
- Garbage bags (general waste)
- Plasterboard
- Food/kitchen waste (excluding waste oil)
- Light globes
- Polystyrene
- Office paper/cardboard
- Plastic – sheeting
- Plastic – hard (helmets, piping, esky)
- Dry paint containers
- Textile – cloth
- Timber (broken pallets)
- Electrical conduit
- Dry cement
- Tyres

### Prohibited Wastes

The following waste must not be placed in the site landfills and is required to be removed offsite:

- Batteries
- Septic waste
- Wet cement
- Asbestos
- Hydrocarbons / Chemicals
- Contaminated materials
  - Soil
  - Water
  - Rags/Filters
  - Containers
- Recyclable materials
  - Cans/glass bottles
  - Black poly piping
  - Unbroken Pallets
  - Scrap metal

**Notes:** (1) The placement of any prohibited waste in the landfill may render the offender liable to prosecution under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*. (2) Fires are not permitted within the landfill area at any time. (3) Further detail on wastes permitted and prohibited are outlined in the Waste Management Procedure OP-PRO-00063.

### Exceptions

Waste permitted to be disposed in the Mine Landfill Facility is dependent on the individual Contractor’s contract or on written approval by Roy Hill Management. It is the Contractor’s responsibility to ensure that they understand their individual conditions of use for the landfill and only dispose of the correct waste types.

### Recording of Waste Types and Volumes

Waste types and volumes disposed at the landfill are to be recorded in the Landfill Waste Register kept at the Mine Landfill Facility.

*I have read through this form and the Waste Management Procedure (OP-PRO-00063), and understand the types of waste that are able to be placed into the site landfill. I agree to prevent prohibited wastes from my work area entering the landfill.*
